**Word Study:** **leisure** Word Class (noun)

**Word Study:** **marvellous** Word Class (adjective)  
Pronunciation / Syllables (mar-vel-lous)

**Definition:** To state that someone or something is very good.

**Word Study:** **mischievous** Word Class (adjective)  
Pronunciation / Syllables (mis-chie-vous)

**Definition:** Someone who likes to have fun by playing tricks or doing things they are not supposed to do.

She rocks back and forth on her chair like a **mischievous** child.

**Word Study:** **muscle** Word Class (noun)  
Pronunciation / Syllables (mus-cle)

**Definition:** A piece of tissue which connects two bones in your body.

Stretching your **muscles** before exercise is very important.

**Word Study:** **necessary** Word Class (adjective)  
Pronunciation / Syllables (nec-es-sar-y)

**Definition:** When something is needed in order for something to happen.

We will do whatever is **necessary** to stop them.

**Word Study:** **neighbour** Word Class (noun)  
Pronunciation / Syllables (neigh-bour)

**Definition:** Someone who lives near you.

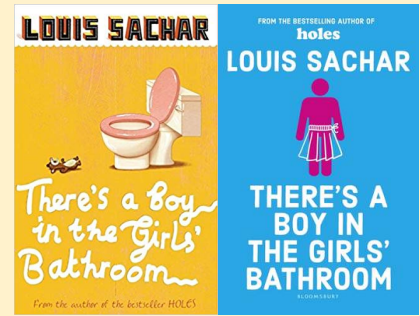
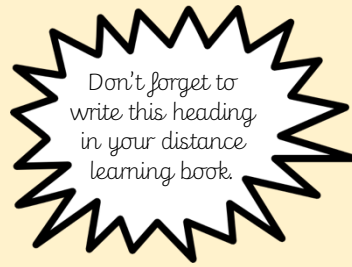
