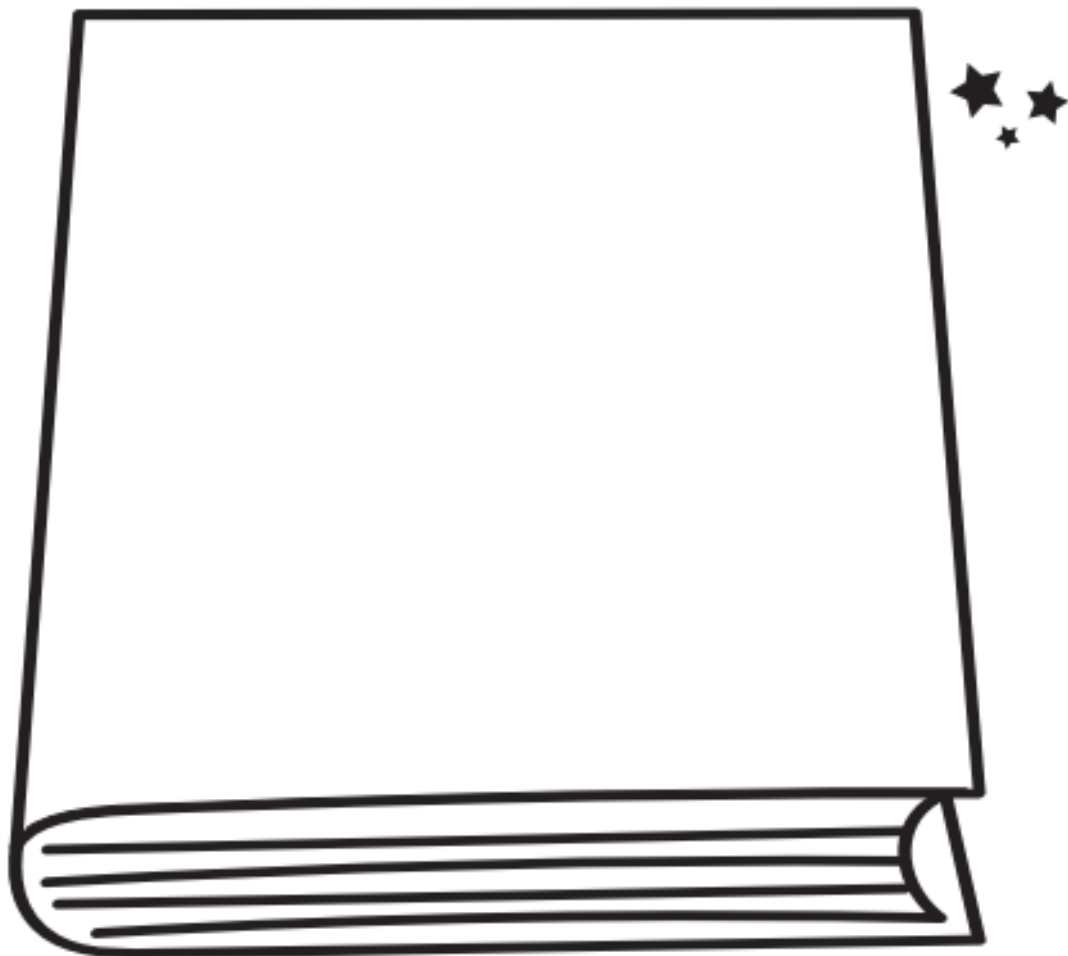


**Design your own

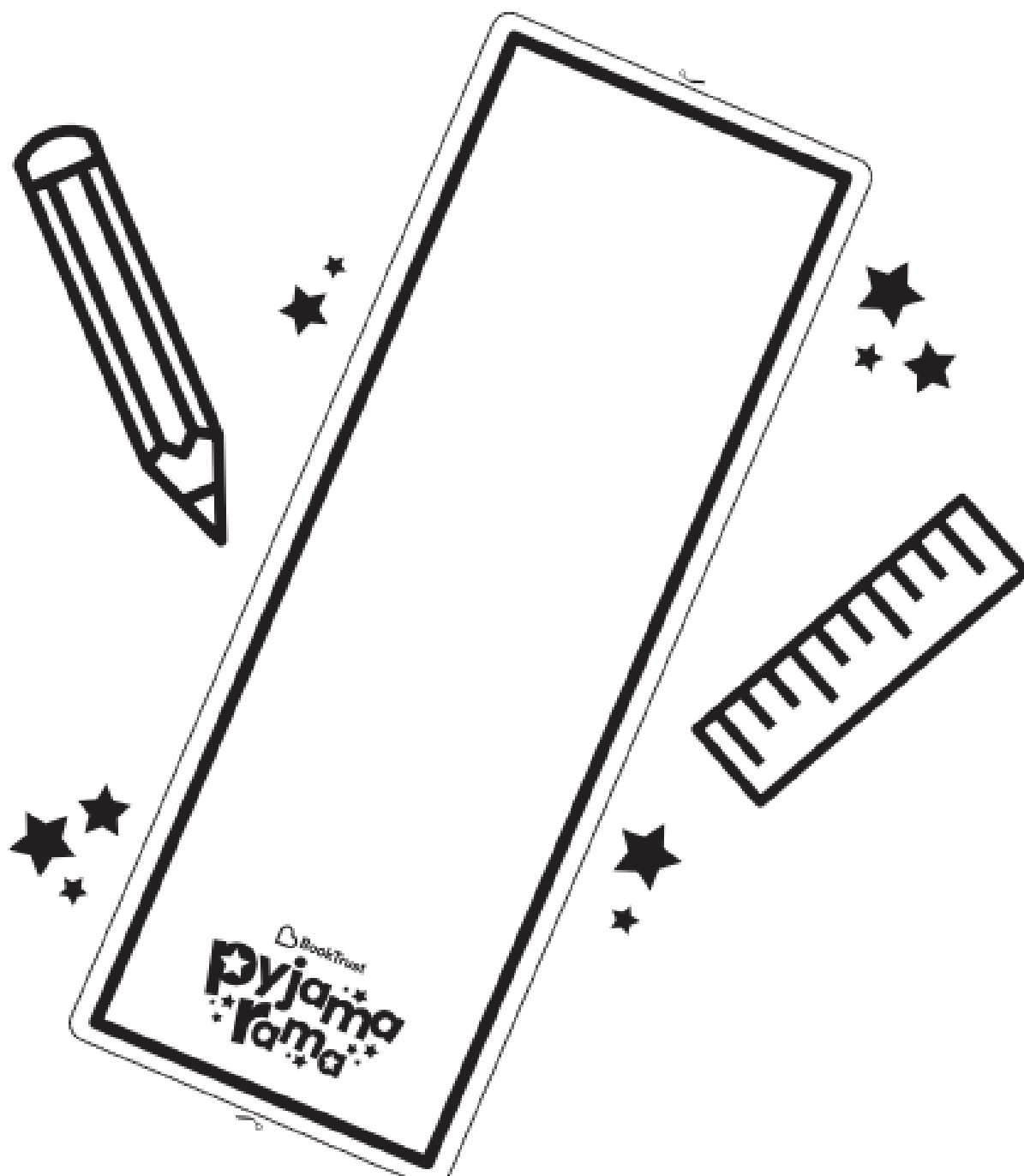

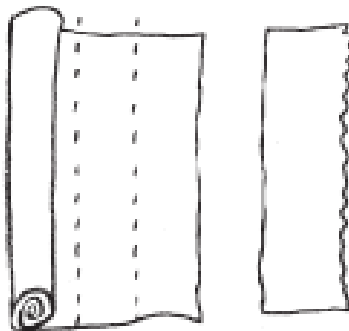


# How to make a FOIL SPIDER (Brilliant!)



Take a roll of **FOIL** and tear  
or cut three strips off.

Be careful or ask an adult if  
you're using scissors.



Fold one strip over and over  
to make a thin but **THICK** leg.



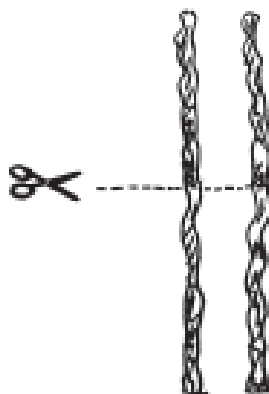
You can  
**SCRUNCH**

them as you go to make them rounder.

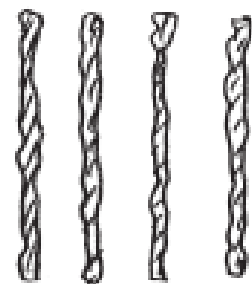
**LIKE THIS**



Now do the same with  
the **OTHER** leg.

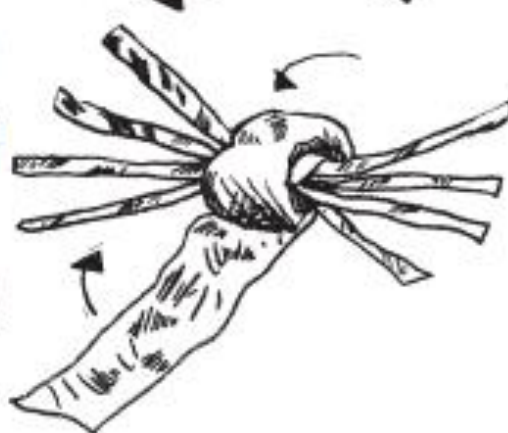
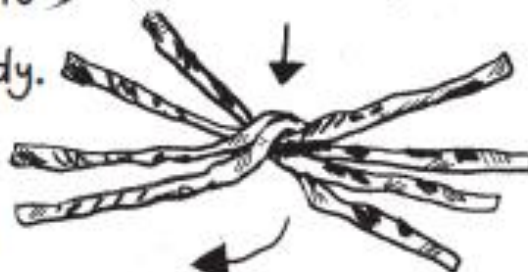


When you have two legs  
together, cut them in the  
middle so you have **FOUR**  
legs the same length.



Put the legs on top of each other in a sort of STAR SHAPE.

Then hold them in the centre and gently TWIST the legs together a little. This makes it easier to make the spider body.



Once you've got your legs, use the other strip of foil to WRAP around the centre of the legs to make a body.



KEEP adding strips of foil and PUSH down the sides to make it into a SPIDER SHAPE until it's the size



you want. Then gently bend the legs up into a SPIDER SHAPE.



You can paint your spider all over - OR just paint on some EYES.
