UKS2 Word Study

Word Study: **queue** Word Class (noun)
Pronunciation / Syllables (queue)

Definition: A line of people or vehicles waiting for something.
Joshua got a tray and patiently waited in the **queue** for lunch.

Word Study: **recognise** Word Class (verb)
Pronunciation / Syllables (rec-og-nise)

Definition: When you know who the person is or what the thing is.
Working carefully, Max **recognised** the mathematical pattern.

Word Study: **recommend** Word Class (verb)
Pronunciation / Syllables (rec-om-mend)

Definition: To suggest a useful person or thing.
I have just spent a holiday there and would **recommend** it to anyone.

Word Study: **relevant** Word Class (adjective)
Pronunciation / Syllables (rel-e-vant)

Definition: Related to what is being discussed or is presently important.
Jack's comment about sport was not **relevant** to our discussion about English.

Word Study: **restaurant** Word Class (noun)
Pronunciation / Syllables (res-tau-rant)

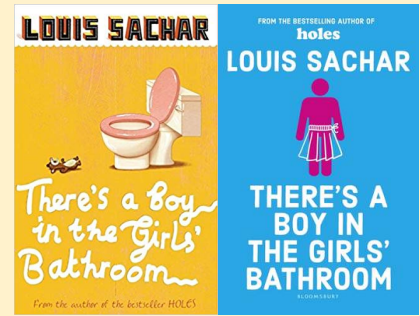
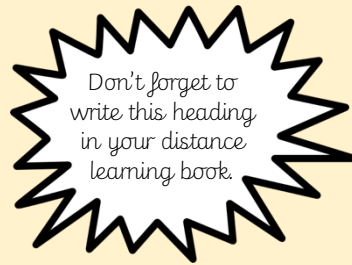
Definition: A restaurant is a place where you can eat food and pay for it.

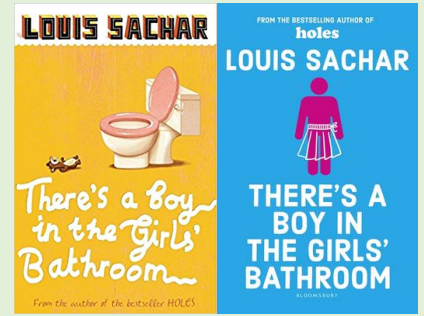
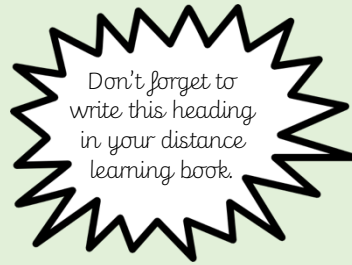

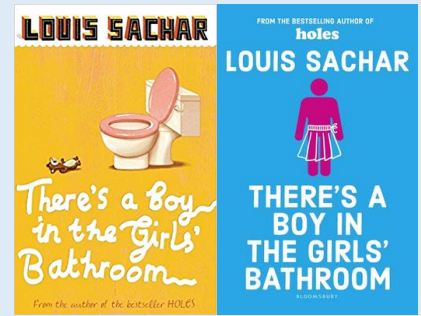
