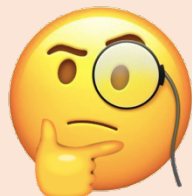
Spelling words

UKS2 Word Study

Word Study: **signature** Word Class (noun)
Pronunciation / Syllables (sig-na-*ture*)

Definition: A person's written name, used to sign documents and letters.

You will need your parent's **signature** to attend after school club.

Word Study: **sincere** Word Class (adjective)
Pronunciation / Syllables (sin-*cere*)

Definition: When you say someone is sincere, you believe they really mean the things they say.

He accepted her apologies as **sincere**.

Word Study: **soldier** Word Class (noun / verb)
Pronunciation / Syllables (sol-*dier*)

Definition: A person who works in the army.

The **soldiers** guarded the entrance to the base.

Word Study: **stomach** Word Class (noun / verb)
Pronunciation / Syllables (stom-*ach*)

Definition: An organ inside your body where food is digested

Ben was off school because he had an upset **stomach**.

Word Study: **sufficient** Word Class (adjective)
Pronunciation / Syllables (suf-*fi-cient*)

Definition: When there is enough of something for a particular purpose.

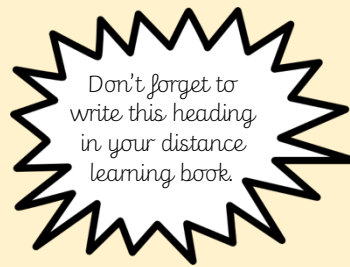
The amount of food here will be **sufficient** for the camping trip.
