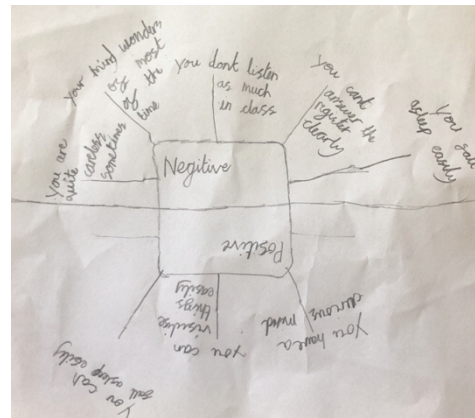

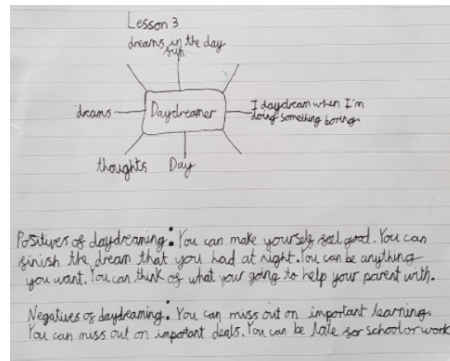
How to bring the poem to life.

- Pause at the end of line.
- 'very carefully' should be said slowly
- 'Accidentally and very carefully' should be said together if reader is in a group.
- 'Accidentally and very carefully' should be said a bit louder.

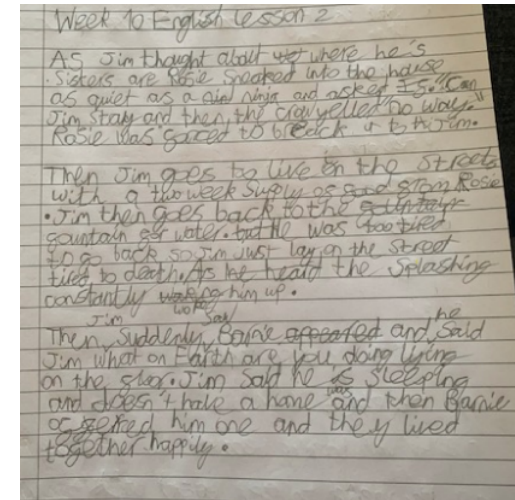
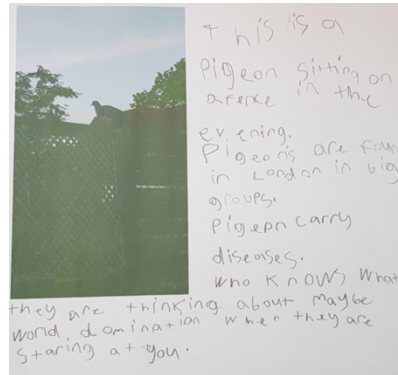
