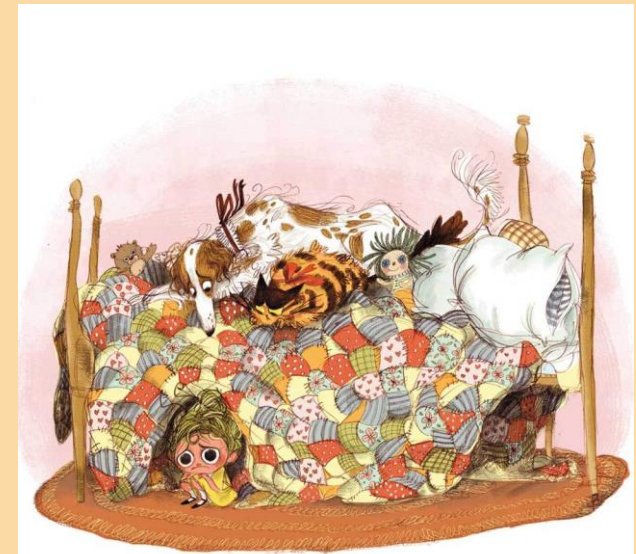
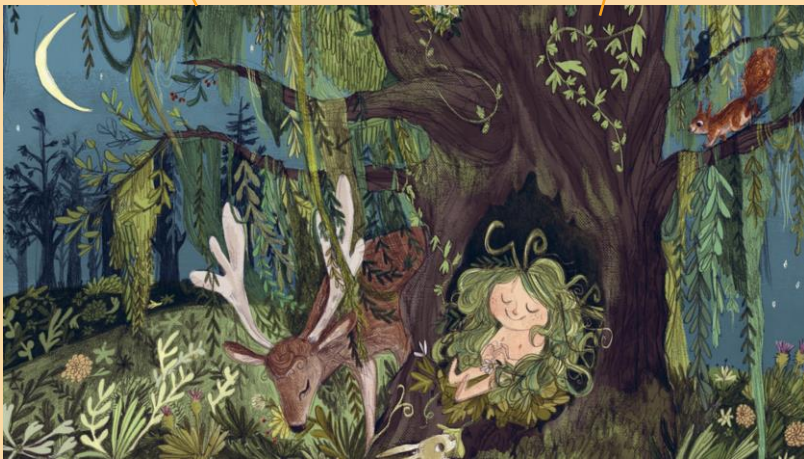
Look at the two pictures taken from different stages in the book.

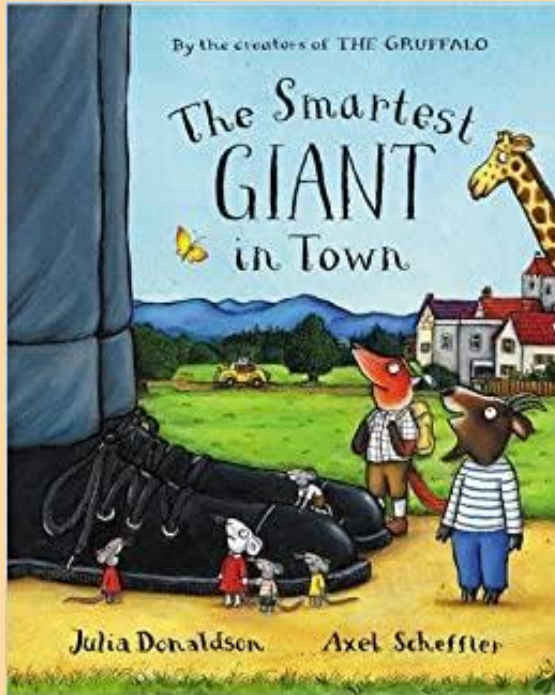
