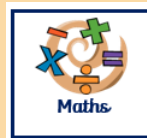

- Where do they live?

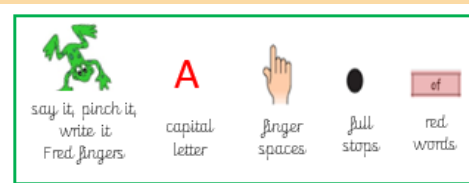

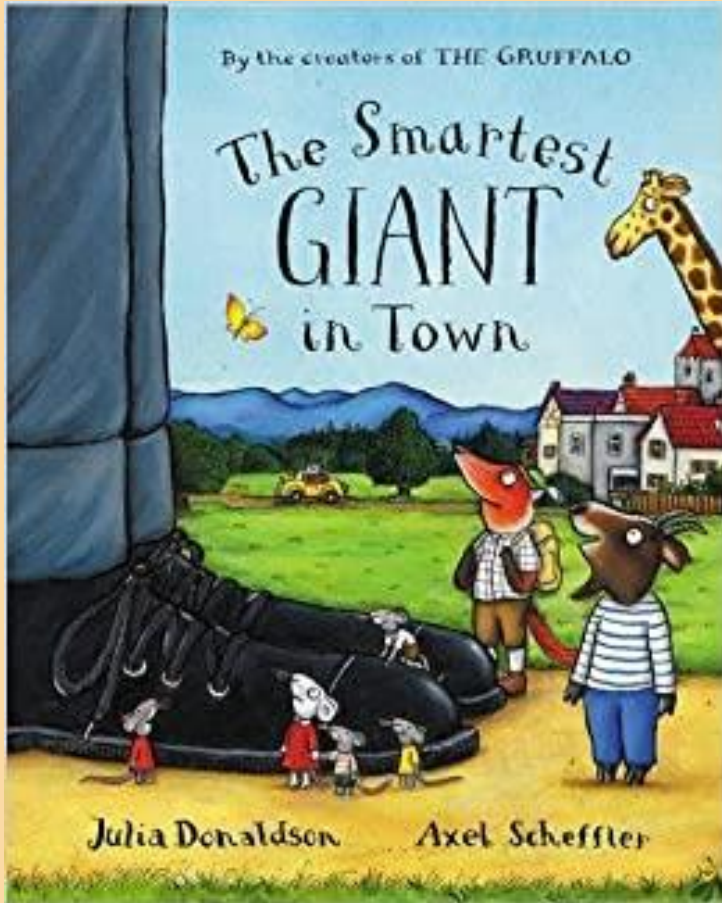
