
# Maths Learning Journey- Place Value to 20

In class we normally have our maths journey on our working wall. Check out where we are and what learning is coming up!

We know this is 10 because the tens frame is full.



There are 7 ones.



Each cube has the value of 1


This is called Base Ten. The stick has the value of 10.

This does not mean one. It means there is one group of ten.

Just because we can't count each individual pencil, we know there are 10 because it says it is a pack of 10.



Counting forwards and backwards 0-20.


