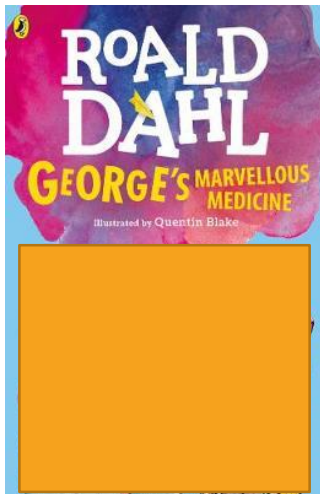
We are starting to read *Georges Marvellous Medicine* by Roald Dahl. If you have a copy of the book at home, please use that.

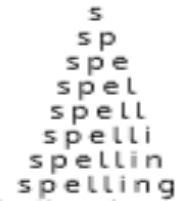
