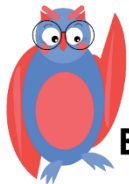

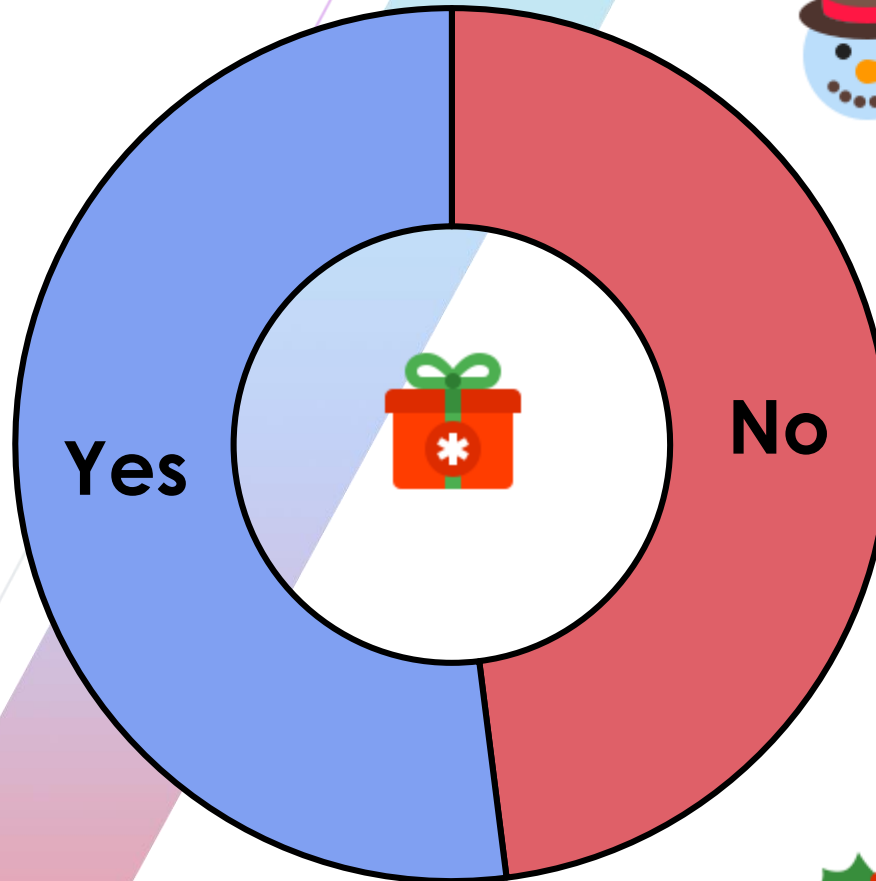

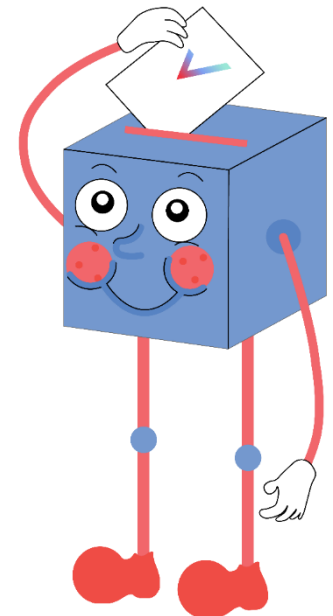

How many countries do you think there are in the world?

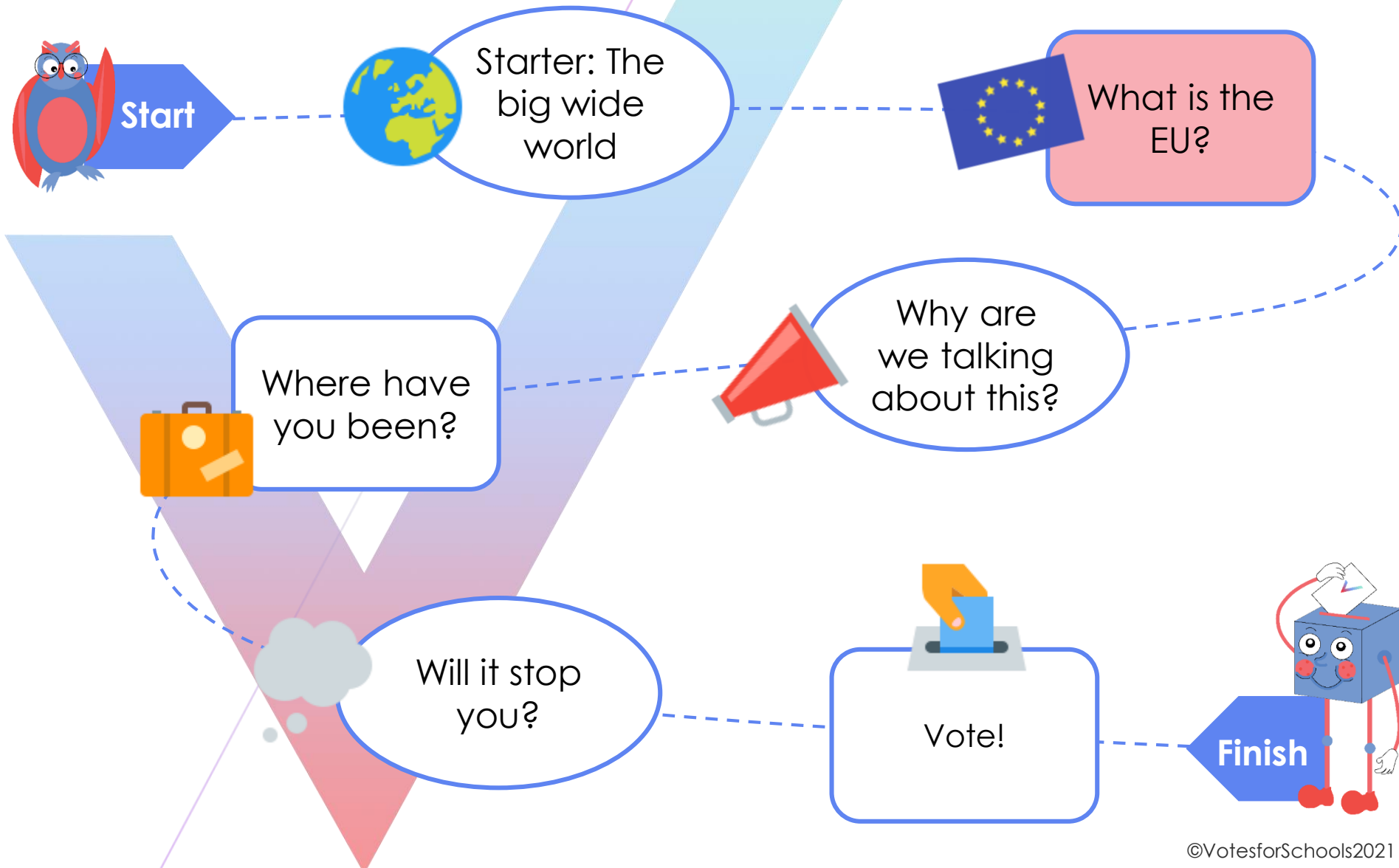
There are **193** countries in the world!

What is the European Union (EU)?



The **UK is part of Europe**. There are **44 countries in Europe**.

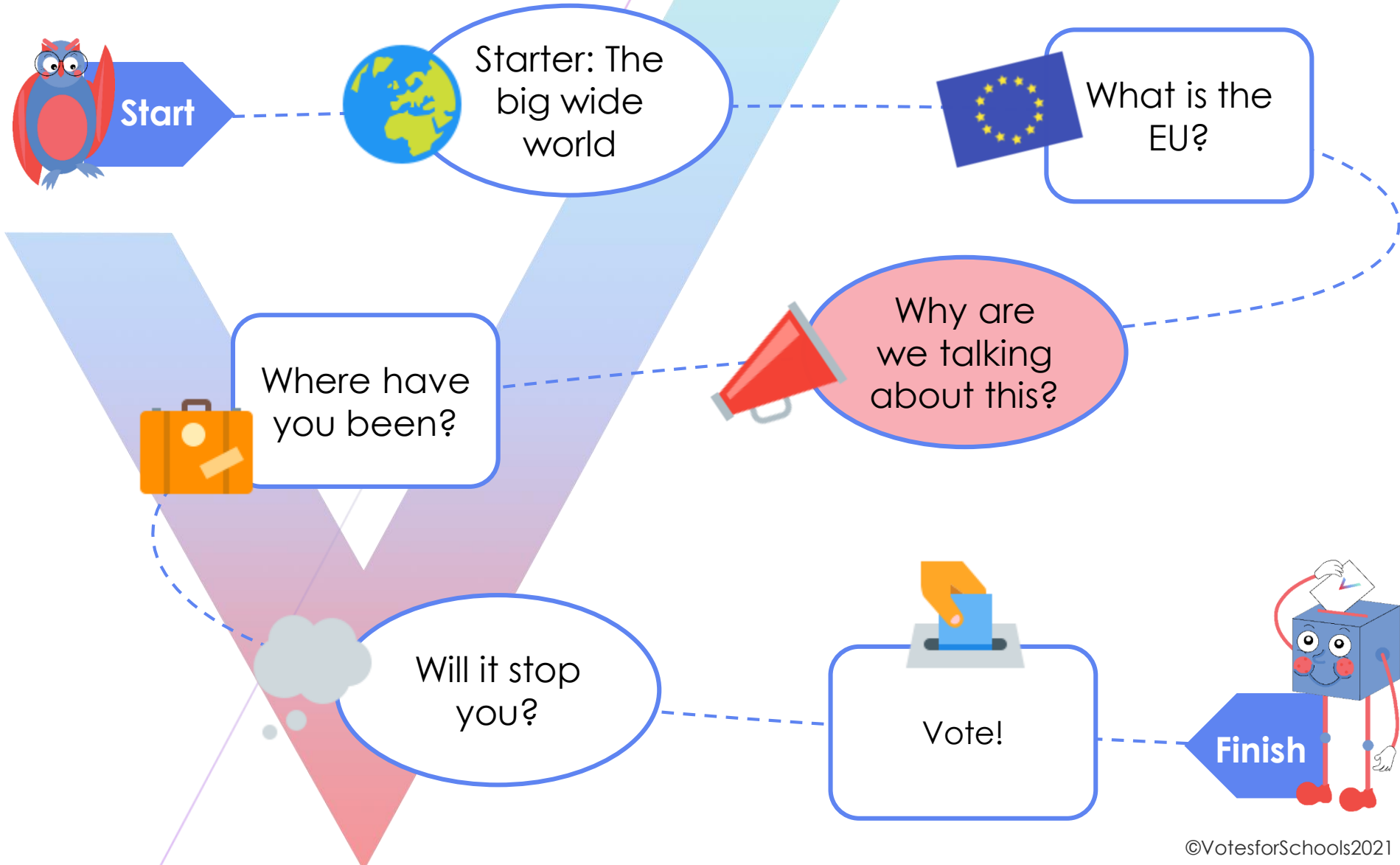
Some of these countries joined together to make the **European Union (EU)**.

The **UK was part of the European Union*** for nearly 50 years before it **decided to leave** the group.

The UK officially left the EU last year, but **at first** not much changed.



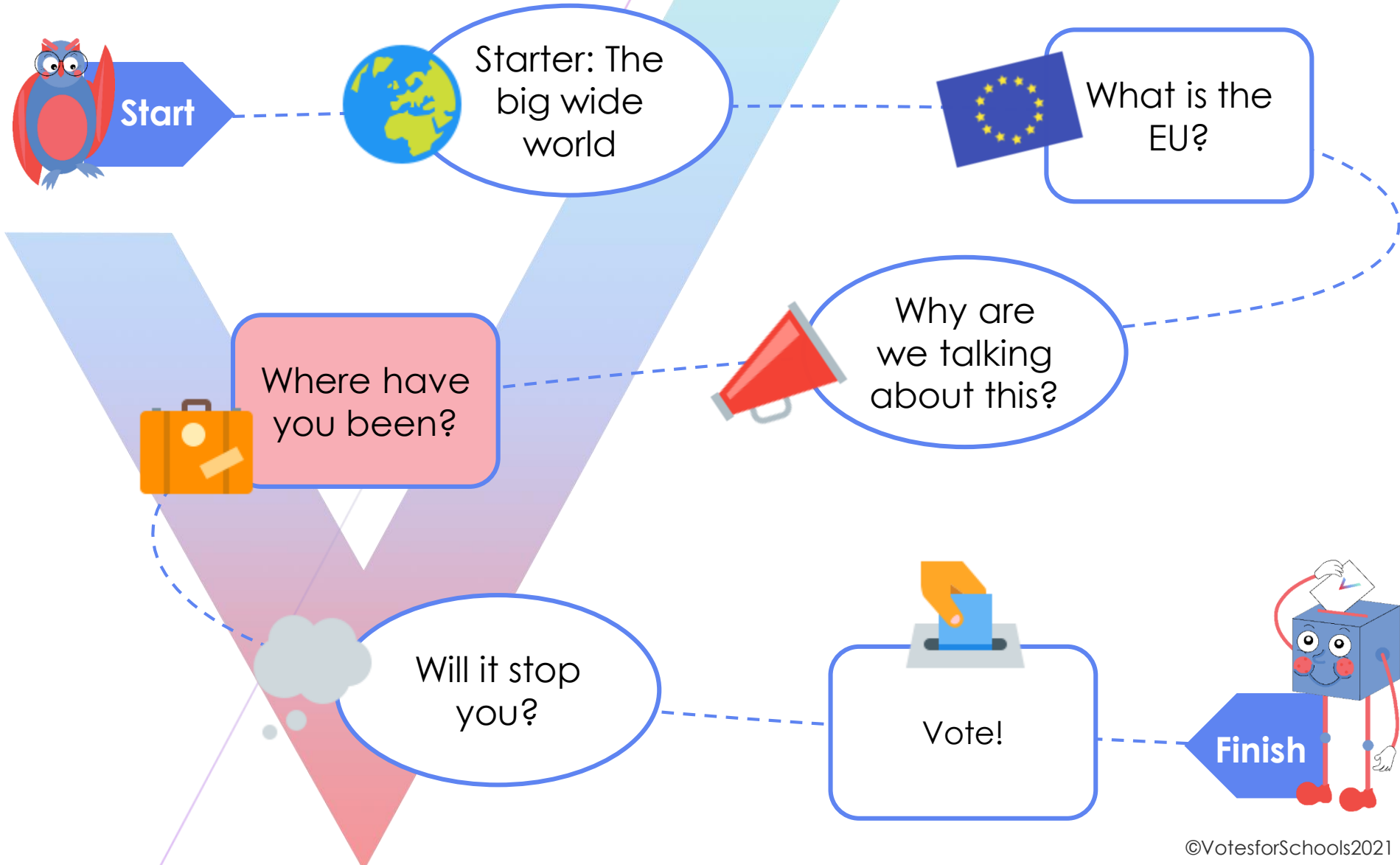
This is because **Boris Johnson** needed to have lots of chats with the EU to **decide which things would change and which would stay the same.**

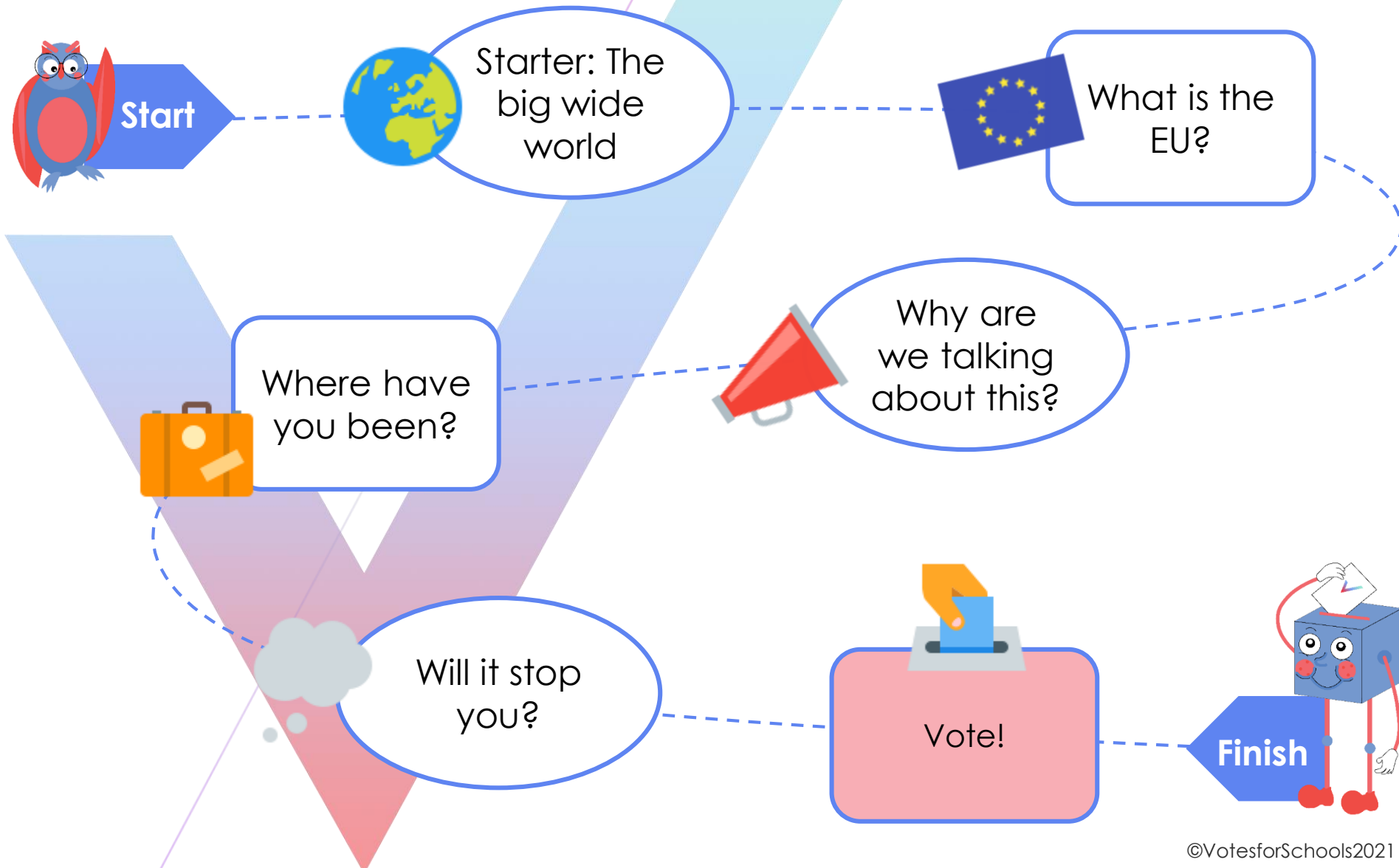
People from the UK can still **drive in other countries**, but they might need to **pay a little bit more** for a permit and insurance for their vehicle.

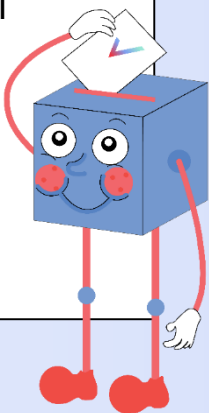

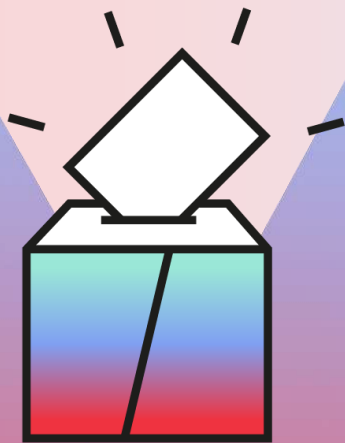

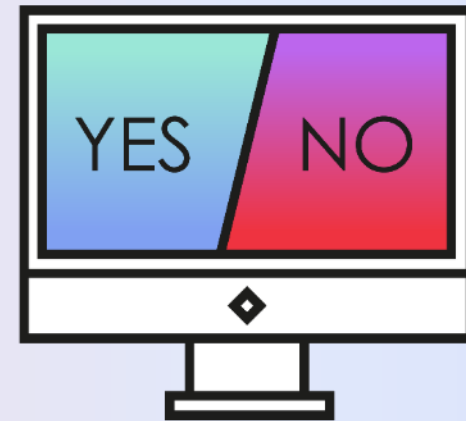
