- The list is all the sandwich parts that go inside the bread.

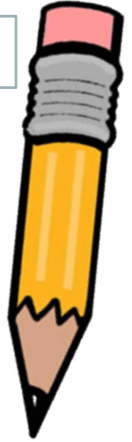
