





Using Apostrophes to Mark Possession

An apostrophe looks like this

It has a number of jobs to do in our writing. One of these is telling our readers when something belongs to someone — possession.


Instead of writing:

It was cold in the house belonging to Faiza.

We can write:

It was cold in Faiza's house.

Apostrophes to Show Possession

Sometimes using the words belongs to doesn't sound right.

For example if we were introducing someone we wouldn't say:

These are the parents that belong to Maddison.

What do you think we would say?

We would probably say:

These are Maddison's parents.

Apostrophes to Show Possession

When we say something belongs to someone, we add an 's' to the end of the word. However we also do this when the word becomes plural.

So we add an apostrophe before the 's' to show our reader we mean 'belongs to'.
