

4. Why was he terrified when he heard Grandma's voice?



<u>Maths –</u> This week we are going to recap on different parts if our learning. Today we are going to look at digital clocks. A digital clock tells the time in 12 hours or 24 hours. Here is a video to help: <u>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=Jmx80UDrDq4</u>



#### <u>What we know</u>



This is an analogue clock.

Each number represents 5 mínutes. When we go past the 12, ít ís 'past' the hour. When we go past the 6, ít ís 'to' the hour.




A 24 hour clock starts at 12:00 (am) and counts to all the way up to 23:00 (11pm). When we get to 12:00 (pm) we continue counting on so that 13:00 would be 1pm, 14:00 would be 2pm etc.


