

<u>Wake and shake</u> - There are many different videos on YouTube for wake and shake or children can follow a Joe Wicks video to get them ready for the day!




Handwriting - children to practice writing descending letters and ensuring that they are hanging below the line

<u> Handwriting -</u>


As it is wellbeing Wednesday we are going to be practising our fine motor and pencil control skills.


We are reading 'Into the Forest' and today we are going to be reading pages 18 - 21:








Properties of a shape: A 2D shape has edges/sides that can be straight or curved.

A 2D shapes can have vertices which are where 2 sides meet and make a point (corner).




Create a picture only using circles. These have to be small circles.
