At New Valley we are working with a school in Nepal as part of a Connecting Classrooms project.


The project is all about being 'United against Waste'.



When you have had a think...


- Look around your home and take photos of different types of waste that you can see.

How to Hold a Pair of Scissors








Maths: measuring time

- We learnt how to measure






- Ask a grown up to time you for one minute.
