This week, we have had some help from **IBM** and the **National Cyber Security Centre (NCSC)** with this topic, and they want to **hear what you have to say** about staying safe online!



What is a digital footprint?



Have you ever heard of a **digital footprint**? If you're not sure what they are, think about **normal footprints** first...


Imagine... (1-2 mins)

What is a digital footprint?



From just a footprint **a policeman would be able to tell....**

Just like in a muddy forest, **you leave behind “digital footprints” every time you use the internet!** Each footprint contains a little **piece of information about you.**

How much you **weigh**
