# History / Geography:

#### In history we will be:

 Learning about The Great Fire of London and how events have impacted our lives today.

#### In Geography we will be:

- Exploring continents and oceans in more detail and making comparisons and contrasts:
- Using maps and atlases.

- · As a school, we use the phonics scheme Little Wandle Letters & Sounds. The first part of Autumn term will have a phonics focus, and then we will be moving on to whole class reading sessions.
- We will be following our 'VIPERS' approach for reading, focusing on the different elements that will help children become confident readers.
- These will be daily lessons and locus on a range of different books.

#### In PE we will be:

- Swimming every Wednesday and continuing to build our skills and confidence;
- Participating in cricket with a coach and learning the skills needed for the sport.
