History / Geography:

In history we will be:

- Learning about The Gunpowder Plot. Remember, remember the fifth of November!

In geography we will be:

- Carrying out an in-depth study about waste and recycling in our school and local area.

Outdoor learning:

- Every week we will be having 'Woodland Wednesday' activities.

RE:

In RE we will be:

- Learning about religious celebrations and festivals;

Music:

In music we will be:

- Exploring rhythm and pattern through singing.

Maths:

As mathematicians we will be:

- Recap numbers to 5 (Autumn 1) and 10 (Autumn 2)
- Learning about place value;
- Developing our knowledge and skills in addition and subtraction;
- Exploring 2D and 3D shapes.

Science:

As scientists we will be:

- Exploring a variety of common animals and understanding how to take care of them;
- Learning about a variety of common animals that are carnivores, herbivores and omnivores;
- Identifying and naming a variety of common wild and garden plants, including deciduous and evergreen trees.

Art / Design and Technology:

- In DT we will be learning about the importance of having a balanced diet, including looking at the 'Eat Well plate'. We will be designing and making a healthy snack.
- In Art we will be exploring colour!

Wellbeing & PSHE:

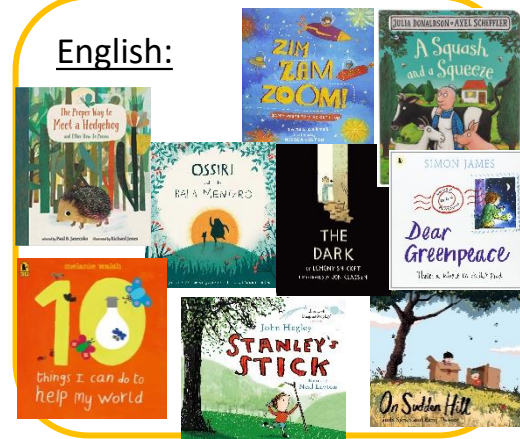
In PSHE and wellbeing we will be:
