Reading

Reading levels have been assessed and as each child is different, they will have different needs when changing their book. <u>History</u>

Our new topic is the Stone Age to Iron Age including The Bronze Age. We will use historical sources to find out what life was like in the Stone Age and compare it to life now.

Science

Our first topic will be plants. We will look at the effects of different factors on plant growth and describe the functions of different parts of the flowering plant. We will investigate the way in which water is transported within plants and explore their life cycle, pollination and the ways in which seeds are dispersed.
