Every child will need to wear their full New Valley P.E. kit into school. We would like to use this opportunity to remind families that there is a set PE kit expectation at New Valley. Please **do not** wear brightly coloured tracksuits or football shirts. This is not part of our PE uniform. If a child comes to school wearing the correct PE kit, they will earn a point for their team.

PE Kit Expectations

- White t-shirt (preferably the New Valley PE top)
- Navy/black shorts or tracksuit bottoms/ leggings
- Plimsolls (indoors) or trainers (outdoors)
- Navy/black sweatshirt
- No jewellery or earrings



The children will need to wear safe and suitable trainers (not plimsolls) as we will be on the field. Please also note that if it is likely to be hot and sunny, please ensure your child has a hat, sun cream (put on at home please) and a refillable water bottle.

The PTFA will also be selling refreshments on the KS2 playground (cash only) for parents during the afternoon and children after school.
