## Theatre Trip to *The Lion King* – YEAR 3 – Date Changed

Dear Y3 Parents/Carers

As you know, we were intending to take Year 3 to *The Lion King* at the Lyceum Theatre on 1<sup>st</sup> February. Rail strikes planned for that day have made it impossible to transport the children, but I am delighted to let you know that we have managed to rearrange this exciting trip.

The new date is **Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> February**. All other details of the trip, including transport and departure times, will remain as planned before; please see below for details. You will also find a reminder of how to complete your payment if you haven't already.

We will be travelling by bus and train, departing at 11:45am and intending to return back to school before **7:00pm**. Updates during the return journey will be sent via text to help give an accurate return time. There will be five members of staff accompanying the children.

Tickets are **£22.50**, and while this is a higher cost than previous trips, we strongly feel that this is an incredible opportunity for children to experience a show like this. It is very rare to see West End theatre tickets at these prices. There will be no further trips that involve any cost for the remainder of Year 3.

Payments should be made online through the ParentPay website ([www.parentpay.com](http://www.parentpay.com)) using your current log-in and password. Once on the site you will see a drop-down menu under payments where you can select your trip and make a payment.

We ask that children come in **full school uniform** and have a waterproof coat. Lunch will be eaten before we depart the school but they will need two snacks and drinks (one for the interval and one for the journey home). They should have no glass containers, and ideally everything should be disposable including the carrier bag.
