Whole School Activity Day

I am delighted to inform you about an exciting opportunity for your child to take part in a whole school activity day at New Valley. This event is part of our 'Health Week' initiative and will take place during normal school hours on Friday 28th June 2024.

During this day, EYFS and Key Stage 1 children will have the opportunity to participate in soft archery and mini golf. Meanwhile, Key Stage 2 children will take part in laser tag and fencing. These activities will be run by an external company called 'The Outdoor Education Company', led by qualified staff.

To ensure the safety and enjoyment of all participants, it is essential that children come dressed in their PE kit, wearing appropriate gripping trainers. Additionally, please ensure they bring jumpers to participate in activities that require long sleeves, otherwise they will not be able to take part. Due to the outdoor nature of some activities, children must bring a water bottle, wear sun cream, and bring a hat to protect themselves from the sun. If it is forecast to rain, they will need to bring a waterproof coat. **Long hair must be tied back.**

I am pleased to share that there will be **no cost** for this special activity day. We will be utilising our sports premium funding to provide this opportunity, with the aim of offering every child a diverse range of experiences and encouraging physical activity.
